

## **Operational Services**

### **Food Services**

Cafeteria and kitchen facilities shall be maintained in schools offering hot lunch programs.

The Superintendent or a designee shall establish such administrative procedures to control food sales which compete with the District's non-profit food service in compliance with the Child Nutrition Act.

Specifically, food service rules shall restrict the sale of foods of minimal nutritional value as defined by the U.S. Department of Agriculture in the food service areas during the meal periods.

Those food service programs receiving federal funds shall comply with State and federal regulations.

All cafe and kitchen facilities shall be maintained in compliance with Illinois Department of Public Health regulations.

The Food Service contract shall be bid at least every 5 years as required by The School Code.
